



HOW TO USE IWALK

1. DOWNLOAD IWALK APPLICATION

- Go to on the App Store (iPhones) or the Google Play Store (Android)
- Search “IWALK Shoah”
- Download the app titled “IWALK – USC Shoah Foundation” Downloading the app will take less than a minute, and will be faster on WiFi versus cellular data

2. OPEN THE IWALK APP

- Select the button that reads “Explore IWALKs”

3. CHOOSE YOUR LOCATION

- Scroll to the bottom of the Countries screen, and select “United States”

4. CHOOSE YOUR TOUR

- Select our general tour, titled “Horwitz-Wasserman Holocaust Memorial Plaza: History of the Holocaust (the first option), or one of the special interest options titled “Horwitz-Wasserman: Holocaust Memorial Plaza: Propaganda & Antisemitism” and “Horwitz-Wasserman: Holocaust Memorial Plaza: Contemporary Antisemitism” (swipe right to view).

5. DOWNLOAD TOUR CONTENT

- Scroll to the bottom of the Preview screen
- Select “Download”
- Select your language (“English”)

- Select the audience (“General Public,” “Middle School,” or “High School”)
- Wait for the tour content to download
- Tour content will take approx. 3 minutes to download, and will be faster on WiFi versus cellular data. We recommend that you download your IWALK tour prior to visiting the Plaza.

6. START YOUR TOUR

- Once your tour is downloaded, select “Start Tour” at the bottom of the screen.
- To view content for each stop of the tour, select one of the stops at the bottom of the screen. Scroll to the right to view different items.
- Tour stops can be made sequentially from 1 through 7, or out of sequence.
- Clicking the individual markers on the map will not display tour content.
- When you select the stop you want to explore, select “Start guide” at the bottom of the screen.
- To move between pages, click the button that reads “continue.” This button is at the bottom of the screen; you may need to scroll to see it.
- To return to the map, click the text reading “Back to Map” below the continue button, or click the “Back to Map” button when you finish your stop.
